**SusanR**: they can fit with all subject areas

KatieCa: Oh wow

**JennyEB**: we had a terrible time with fact and opinion last week - time for a graphic

organizer to the rescue

**AshleyRC**: cool website

**KatieCa**: we're working on a flow chart this week in science...natural resources

**SusanR**: and I do have a handout for you

**SusanR**: nice collection...pretty straight forward

**ConnieF**: These are really nice

**JennyEB**: our current selection is Gail Gibbons Frogs, the graphic organizer suggested involves compare and contract - I think I'll kill 2 birds and write some facts/opinions regarding frogs/toads!

**SusanR**: and I don't know if this is a graphic organizer but I do like this for the young ones

**JennyEB**: WHOAAAAAA SUE I just made my own FROG star GO in the worksheet one - that is soooooooo AWESOME!

**BJB2** smiles

**JennyEB**: Phooey on TEACHERVISION!

**SusanR**: The next set has a fishbone; and the set is interactive;

**SusanR**: you will be pleased

**SusanR** nods to Jenny

**JennyEB**: interactive?

SusanR: It's called Classtools

**SusanR**: These are so much better than the reproducible graphic organizers because they are interactive, and can even be posted. to classroom blogs or wikis if you wish

**ConnieF**: are you talking about teachervision or worksheets.com

**SusanR**: There are currently 15 different graphic organizers to choose from including Venn diagram, fishbone and timeline and more are being updated

SusanR: CLASSTOOLS, Connie ..this is it

**AshleyRC**: can the children use them too?

**JennyEB** . o O ( no w I've gotten everyone confused, sorry )

**SusanR**: Here is a nice way to create graphic organizers to develop student understanding, save paper, keep it in a central place for students to access on a later date and easily share with other like minded colleagues.

**SusanR**: Try it out and let me know what you think.

**SusanR**: I am trying to make up for lost time, Jenny

**B.IB2** waits for the url

**SusanR** . o O ( the site has been revised )

**AshleyRC**: I have actually used the count down timer before

**AshleyRC**: the kids loved it

**SusanR**: very student friendly...

**JennyEB**: are you trying to tell me I can make my own arcade games?

**JennyEB**: they've gotta be kidding

SusanR: yes, Jenny

**JennyEB** . o O ( I've died and gone to teacher heaven )

**SusanR** gives everyone a chance to catch their breath

**ConnieF**: This is really cool.

**AshleyRC**: this would be great for centers

ConnieF: Yes!

**KatieCa**: lots of great resources here

**SusanR**: you can save as a web page and embed in a blog ...

ConnieF: wow

**SusanR**: yuck..they have advertising

**JennyEB**: OMG there's a timer with the theme from the Avengers

**BJB2**: Are these resources free of charge?

**BJB2**: A. Yes! There is no charge for creating resources with any of these templates. The site is supported by Google Ads.

**JennyEB**: I'm trying the Indiana Jones 5 minute timer in math TOMORROW

**JennyEB**: I'm obsessing on these timers - I have to look at something else

**SusanR**: I spent quite a bit of time exploring Classtools

**SusanR**: ok something else

**AshleyRC**: the priority chart is neat

**SusanR**: Thanks to BjB ..this is a web 2.0 tool; great for teacher planning...working with colleagues or collaborating

**SusanR**: called Exploratree.

**SusanR**: Exploratree is a free web resource where you can access a library of ready-made interactive thinking guides, print them, edit them or make your own. You can share them and work on them in groups too.
