SusanR: have you heard about the site?

MelissaPar: No, I haven't

SusanR: Wordnik may be the most robust online dictionary on the web.

SusanR: and search engine too

SusanR: great for students starting a topic or theme

SusanR: try it and enter biodiversity or any other term

SusanR: http://www.wordnik.com/words/biodiversity

SusanR: and see what transpires

BrittanyBe joined the room.

SusanR: Welcome Brittany

MelissaPar: WOW. A lot more information than a regular dictionary

SusanR: we are looking at Wordnik, Brittany

MelissaPar: I really like how they give so many examples of the word in a sentence

SusanR: Wordnik offers definitions from multiple sources, examples of the word used in literature, links to related words, image related to the word, pronunciation recordings, the etymology of words, and real-time uses of a word on Twitter.

SusanR: The variety of content formats on Wordnik means that there is something with which almost every student can connect.

MelissaPar: The pictures will be very helpful also

SusanR: It's an excellent online dictionary to share with students because presents definitions and content in a variety of ways.

SusanR: The aim of Wordnik is to show as much information as possible for every word in English.

SusanR: Much more fun than the standard online dictionaries. The additional information is particularly useful for learners of English.

MelissaPar: They are asking for contributions. Does that mean that anyone can add to this site?

SusanR: I believe if you register and you can add you own notes

MelissaPar . o O (I will use site in my classroom)

SusanR: How would you use it, Melissa

MelissaPar: When we are working on projects, particularly science, I will use this to help with capturing the true meaning of words

SusanR: plus, there is a nice little feature which tells you how many times the word has been viewed and you can even click on an audio button to hear the word spoken (great for Spelling Bee practice).

BrittanyBe: I really like how there are pictures ... gives the students a real life connection

MelissaPar: Brittany, what grade do you teach?

BrittanyBe: I just finished student teaching in December and I finished the school year out as a long term substitute in 2nd grade for 2 months and 3rd grade for two months. I have not been told what grade I will be teaching for next year. All I know is 2nd, 3rd, or 4th
