JohnathanC: I did create a sample video for the class

JohnathanC: I'll show you the directions first

AbdulKh: YEP

JohnathanC: Going to post a link to my HW page...

BJB2 . o O (a reminder that when John shows you a url, hold down the ctrl key on your keyboard to override pop up blockers)

JohnathanC: Scroll down and you will see links to music video documents

JohnathanC: take a moment, they open as word documents so my students can access at home or print another copy if lost

LeeanneW: I was working with a second grader today with poetry. We were discussing the types of words used and what mood the author was trying to create. I can't see the lyrics, but can imagine the lesson.

BJB2: could be civil rights

JohnathanC: Leeanne the link didn't open?

LeeanneW: I got lost last time I tried to open, so I hate to try again

BJB2: we'll find you if you get lost!

JohnathanC: Ok well listen carefully

LeeanneW: OK, tell me again what I do

BJB2: hold down the ctrl key when you click on the url

BJB2: a new window or tab will open for you
