BJB2: anyone can be a musician

BJB2: can be used for fundraisers...create a CD that can be marketed

BJB2: have to download musicshake but is not a huge file

BJB2. o O (free download)

BJB2: left side of software is "tracks" for various instruments

BJB2: on right is sections of time for that track

BJB2: you can combine as many tracks as you wish. The musicshake program takes care of the actual music

BJB2: one track can be a sample of vocals. The demo is using a female humming vocal...very cool!

BJB2: demo used only 5 tracks, but you can add many more

BJB2: you can also adjust the volume

BJB2: musicshake does the work of harmonizing and blending all tracks

BJB2: you can adjust the volume of each track

BJB2: over 500,000 music samples available. All samples created by musicshake musicians...so no copyright issues

BJB2: after you create music you can post to musicshake.

BJB2: you can download as MP3, send to facebook, ringtone, social networks

BJB2: students can add music to videos, slideshows, etc. without violating copyright

BJB2: you do have to pay if you download your music...very low fee

BJB2: does anyone have any questions?

KihongB: so we are back!

BJB2: we're all coming back to TI to ask questions

BJB2 cheers wildly

KihongB: it's kinda strange moving from here and there on the web haha

LuandaR: yes but it was fun

KihongB: I feel like I'm on a time machine or something

MarleneK: That was very cool :)

LuandaR: thanks so much for such an interesting lesson

KihongB bows

BJB2: great example of how Ti can be used as a Learning Hub...using other applications to extend the features of Tapped In

MarleneK nods.
