SusanR: Let me say a few words about Jennifer Wagner.

SusanR: One of her many passions is online projects for students.

SusanR: ..and teacher I guess

SusanR: I'm delighted and excited to have Jen Wagner with us again giving us an update to her online project based on the film Charlotte's Web.

SusanR: Jen puts it together for us with links, activities, lesson ideas, resources and collaborative ideas to readily integrate into your curriculum.

SusanR: Again the topic tonight is Reading Strategies featuring Charlotte's Web and starring Jen Wagner.

RachelWa: I am excited!

JenW: Hello everyone

JenW: We are going to be covering a lot of ground tonight

JenW: and YES, the soundtrack is AWESOME

SusanR: Sarah McLachlan sings her hit song as well

JenW: the TEACHING tools part

JenW: anyway -- that is their teacher resources site

JenW: lots of ideas -- printouts -- worksheets -- etc

JenW: not by grade level though

CourtneyB: wow!

JenW: I will give you a bit to bookmark the site -- and look around

EllenA: Is it suitable for kindergarten?

JenW: OH YES

KellyAS: what about the secondary level?

RachelWa: Thank you

KeyanaJ: I remember Babe Pig In The City

RochelleA: that's a sweet website

JenW: it tells you about making the movie, information about inside the book, as well as teaching tools

JenW: Is anyone here in a FAITH based school???

JenW: this site

JenW: http://www.charlotteswebresources.com/

JenW: brings a spiritual aspect to the book

DairaV: no

MichelleVT: no

KeyanaJ: no

CaitlinO: I'm at a faith based college.. not sure if I'm going to be at a faith based elem.

school or not

JenW: lots of friendship -- etc

JenW: anyway - you can view it later -- it has great stuff as well

JenW: AND a great BULLETIN board ideas

JenW: okay --

JenW: now - LOL -- drumroll

KeyanaJ: I really like this site

JenW: I am putting together a project for teachers about the book

JenW: I will take you to the first page -- and then we can walk through it

AndriaP: that is great!

KeyanaJ: ok

HuongT: good

EllenA: thanks

DairaV: great

JenW: http://www.technospudprojects.com/Projects/webproject/cwhome.htm

CourtneyB: cool

KellyAS: good

SusanR listens attentively to Jen

JenW: that will take you to the home page

MichelleVT: awesome

RachelWa: yeah

JenW: because YOU the teacher and YOUR class are going to make your own project

JenW: after you read the book --

JenW: or discuss the book or movie

JenW: and remember there is a cartoon movie with Debbie Reynolds playing Charlotte

DairaV: neat

JenW: and the Brady Bunch kids sing the songs

RachelWa: I can't wait

JenW: your class will create some way of showing off what they learned

JenW: via a blog

JenW: or a wiki

JenW: or a powerpoint

CourtneyB: wiki?

JenW: or a photosharing website

MichelleVT: wiki?

KellyAS: wiki?

RachelWa: What is a photosharing website?

JenW: LOL -- lets get back to wiki in just a moment

JenW: OKAY -- one at a time

JenW: A blog -- this is where they could discuss the book

JenW: a site such as edublogger or blogmeister would host the blog

CaitlinO: I like the idea of an online discussion

JenW: you could ask your students questions and they can answer them

JenW: or they could ask each other questions

RochelleA: blogger is easy to use too

KellyAS: blogging is a great alternate to journal

JenW: Okay -- WIKIs

JenW: wiki's are like blogs -- but pages instead of journals

JenW: let me show you a wiki

DairaV: great...this is kind of like a journal entry

KellyAS: ooooohhhh okay

CynthiaRT: yikes this is the fastest discussion I've ever seen. . .

RochelleA: but u can change the info on wiki's right

JenW: http://theincrediblejourney.wikispaces.com/

JenW: more than a journal -

CourtneyB: can't look away for one sec!

JenW: you read by page rather than by date

JenW: So - to use a wiki

CaitlinO: Interesting, I've never seen anything like that before

AndriaP: wow..that is really neat!

DairaV: neat

JenW: a teacher might wish to create character pages

MichelleVT: that sounds cool

RachelWa: hum

JenW: such as Charlotte, Wilbur, Templeton, etc

KellyAS: sounds good

GlyndiA: I've never heard of this before

JenW: and have students post data

GlyndiA: very interesting

RachelWa: interesting!

JenW: wikispaces.com will host your site there

JoleenF: How neat!

JenW: for free

CourtneyB: me neither

CynthiaRT: I can't see any of what you are talking about but I will try from the

transcript.

EllenA: very cool

JenW: OOOO -- I am glad to show you about WIKIs

KellyAS: FREE....YES!

DairaV: free is my favorite word, especially right now

SusanR . o O (Would you care to come back again and do a session on WIKIS, Jen)

CourtneyB: I LOVE learning new tools to use!

JenW: hang on -- let me grab a link

JenW: Yes

JenW: http://www.technospud.com/wikiideas.htm

JenW: that tells you all about WIKIS

BJB2: there are two upcoming wiki discussions, Sue...check the calendar

JenW: and there is a powerpoint on how to set it up

MichelleVT: thank you

SusanR checks the calendar

JenW: Okay -- so wikis

EmilyJ: thanks

JenW: and also PowerPoint

CourtneyB: thanks that's a new favorite for me to use now!

JenW: and you all know PowerPoint

JenW: ???

EmilyJ: yes

JenW: good --

DairaV: more or less

NormaSp: I do..

AndriaP: yes!

CaitlinO: of course

JoleenF: yes

GlyndiA: absolutely

MichelleVT: yes, I'm familiar

CourtneyB: of course

JenW: they also could create a PHOTO SHARE

CourtneyB: hee hee

KeyanaJ: yea

JenW: such as like at bubbleshare.com or flickr.com

JenW: again - a free site to share photos

CourtneyB: flickr is cool too

JenW: pictures they take of their class and how they did the Charlotte's Web project

CaitlinO: flickr is a great photo site

JenW: OKAY lets backtrack a bit

KellyAS: please

CynthiaRT: Barely sorry a new teacher this year and just getting computer literate after an incredibly difficult intern year through my intern year at MTEC

JenW: The ACTIVITY page of the project

DairaV: I didn't know things like this existed...especially for FREE

JenW: has 21 ideas of what to do with your class

JenW: http://www.technospudprojects.com/Projects/webproject/cwactivities.htm

JenW: and YOU the teacher

JenW: choose how you wish to show off what you and your class learned

KellyAS: what about the secondary level?

JenW sighs -- should have said that first

CourtneyB: wow

JenW: Kelly -- adaptable easily

JoleenF: awesome!

GlyndiA: this is awesome!

CourtneyB: there are a lot of activities

JenW: AND -- LOL -- it gets better

KeyanaJ: I remember you talking about the web last session

EllenA: do tell...

KellyAS: thank you Susan

SusanR: Jen, can you take us step by step thro' the project and Walden Media site please

CourtneyB: yes, thanks a bunch!!

JenW: okay

RachelWa: Wow! I wish we would have received more information on resources during our past years in college

JenW: #1 -- Teachers join the project

CourtneyB: me too

JenW: #2 -- Teachers look at the different activities and decide how they would like to show off what their students do

JenW: either a wiki, powerpoint, podcst, blog, etc

JenW: they can also use the resources at Walden

NormaSp: wow that is great Jen

JenW: by January 15th --

JenW: teachers will send me the link to what they created

JenW: and I will link to their site - or blog -- or wiki -- or podcast lol

JenW: or photoshare

CaitlinO: So everyone would be able to see what you had done

SusanR . o O (and I do have a simple blog you can use to get you up and running in moments if you are not quite comfortable with WIKIS yet)

AndriaP: that is incredible!!!

JenW: yes

CourtneyB: wow

JenW: yes -- I would use blogmesiter.com

JenW: or edublogs.com

KellyAS: good deal

JenW: if you have a mac

HelenK: can you link to your project with an LMS like Moodle?

JenW: use your dot mac account

SusanR: or tastyword.com

JenW: YES -- a moodle is great

JenW: yes -- anything will work

RachelWa: I can't believe all this technology! It is fascinating!

EllenA: what is a moodle

JenW: ---- need to mark that tastyword.com site down

CynthiaRT: I am really completely clueless about what you are all talking about. . .

JenW: A Moodle is a participant area where you can share ideas

JenW: worksheets, etc

DairaV: this is great...and my students look for any reason to use the computer!

HelenK: moodle is a learning management system that lets you create a class and do the work there

CourtneyB: man I'm learning a lot of new stuff tonight!

JenW: the only problem with a moodle is that usually you have to be a member to see what is there

EllenA: sounds great!

CaitlinO: that's pretty cool

JenW: so -- you know what -- a moodle might not work

SusanR: for your records ..look at it later please http://www.tastyword.com/

JenW: you can also create a website

JenW: and there are TONS of sites where you can host for free

JenW: try teacherweb.com

JenW: or google pages

DairaV: ok..these are the sites I need for later

KellyAS: teacherweb is great

JenW: www.teacherweb.com

JenW: or you could create a podcast

SarahAF: I have never been there

JenW: and host it through www.podomatic.com

GlyndiA: I saw that podcast activity.. that is so neat!

JenW: SO -- see -- you have to create something

JenW: BUT -- we are showing you the tools to do so

CaitlinO: I love podcasts, I would definitely want to try that with my students

CourtneyB: me too

RachelWa: I have never heard of podcasts

JenW: AND if you don't want to create something --

JenW: you can just use the resources on my site

JenW: and don't register ----

SarahAF: me either. what are they?

JenW: LOL - and no one would ever know

CourtneyB: thank you- you are awesome Jen!

GlyndiA smiles

GlyndiA: haha

DairaV: LOL

SusanR: can you give us the link, Jen .. to the resources on your site

JenW: Podcast -- you record using your computer or an ipod (or any mp3 player)

SusanR: for ease of use and simplicity you may want to give http://odeo.com/ a try for instant podcasting

CarolCN: Then, how do I create the podcast?

JenW: you would gather your kids around the microphone

JenW: perhaps do a book review

JenW: or perhaps ask questions -- like a reporter

JenW: but let them be the reporter

JenW: like at the FAIR

JenW: or at the first sighting of the web

JenW: or let them write an alternate ending

JenW: and record those

JenW: just some ideas

SusanR: create and put on a Readers Theater

JenW: yes -- that too

DairaV: I like the idea of alternate endings. the students get very creative

JenW: yes -- especially since there is death in this book

JenW: kids like to recreate it

CarolCN: Great ideas. Then how do you generate the RSS feed that people can subscribe to?

AndriaP: that is such a sensitive subject

JenW: Carol -- no rss feed
