**KaitlynS**: you do have to register for this site.

**BJB2**: very nice. Is there a fee?

**KaitlynS**: I have taken several of the English/Reading workshops and they are fabulous

**DianeDP**: This is good to know for those wanting to earn re-cert points

KaitlynS: Best thing is, it is absolutely free.

KaitlynS: On the left, you will see requirements based on State.

KaitlynS: Click on that

KaitlynS: You will then see a blue map

KaitlynS: click on your state and you will see the process for your particular state

CindyAM joined the room.

BJB2: good, Cindy. Kaitlyn just showed us http://www.paec.org/teacher2teacher/

CindyAM : Hi Kaitylyn

**DanaMB**: Wow this is great!

KaitlynS: This website offers readings, some videos, and a rubric for implementation.

KaitlynS: Any thoughts or questions?

**BJB2**: very nice

**DianeDP**: well thought out

**BJB2**. o O (we've been trying to get TI members to support certificates for participation in the TI events )

**KaitlynS**: I have found that the "certificate" part of it gives it formality and is a bit more convincing for my former principal.

**DanaMB**: It's certainly better to have the certifications than turning in all the paper work...

**BJB2**: absolutely!

**DianeDP**: state departments sometimes require prior approval

KaitlynS: Agreed!

DanaMB: But I shouldn't complain. Tapped In has been approved at the district level.

**KaitlynS**: Some of you may have heard of the next one, but it has definitely help me out with teaching the writing process with my students. <u>http://4teachers.org/</u>

KaitlynS: Has anyone had any success with this website before?

DanaMB: I've used the rubistar before...I guess I didn't know they had other information

**BJB2**: I think they have a group room in TI

**BJB2** checks

KaitlynS: The think tank and persuade star is quite nice for writing.

**BJB2**: Purpose: Facilitate learning various 4teachers tools: Trackstar, Rubistar, Quizstar, etc.

**BJB2**. o O ( that's the 4Teachers group )

KaitlynS: Students can create a user name and password that are all sent to the teacher.

KaitlynS: Teachers can constantly monitor the progress of the students work and send

them editing messages as well.

**KaitlynS**: Also, with the quizstar, you can create video based (1 minute per question) questions.

JeffC: back... yup... we have a 4teachers group here at Tapped In.

KaitlynS: There is also a link for video tutorials on how to use several of the tools

**JeffC**: How much does QuizStar cost now? I know it used to be free, but when the feds pulled their funding, I know they had to change over to a fee based system.

**KaitlynS**: Did they?

**JeffC** nods sadly

KaitlynS: I haven't used it at all this year with my current teaching placement.

**JeffC**: I'll check.

KaitlynS: Thanks Jeff

**KaitlynS**: 60 day free trial

**JeffC**: QuizStar requires a subscription. Start your 60-day free trial now, and choose from subscriptions as low as \$3.25 a month. Rates

**KaitlynS**: QuizStar definitely enhanced the way I assessed. Even though there is a charge, I would recommend it.

SusanR: I have been a huge fan of trackstar for many years

JeffC agrees with Kaitlyn and Susan.

**KaitlynS**: Depending on the population of students you teach, a great resource on autism that I found is <u>http://www.autismnetwork.org/</u>

KaitlynS: It does not offer a certificate, but I really like the set up of this online resource.

**SusanR**: Please excuse me I have to pop out for an exercise class! Thanks for the resources Kaitlyn and welcome to the TI community.
